Culinary Scholarship

Available to Pine Manor residents, Military Veterans and Southwest Florida residents who demonstrate financial need and meet scholarship requirements.

Requirements

- Proof of Pine Manor or Lee County for more than three years, may be waived with special consideration by Scholarship Review Committee.
- Proof of Honorable Discharge from military service
- At least 18 years old and plan on working fulltime (38-45 hours per week) in Southwest Florida for the next 3 years.
- EITHER Be currently unemployed with proof of State or Federal Aid OR demonstrate a financial need with proof of household income of more than 11,000 and less than 35,000
- Agree to provide 30 minutes of community service for 120 credit/contact hour provided in program
- Attend 95% of the program
- Successfully complete Externship
- Successfully complete the required program curriculum with 80% GPA
- Satisfactorily complete Scholarship essay forms provided by program administrators
- Follow the program guidelines, policies, codes of conduct, and instructor direction
- Permit a confidential background check performed by a recognized agency
- Have an ability to potentially be exposed to media in a variety of forms
- Participate in post graduate surveys and questionnaires
- Agree to all terms and conditions including and not limited to personal tuition reimbursement for non-completion or failure to meet scholarship and program requirements

This is a competitive scholarship that covers all programming costs for 12 weeks personal development course focused on culinary skills, sustainable agriculture, and nutritional wellbeing, and must be e-mailed to icare4food@gmail.com or in person at Pine Manor Improvement Association by Friday January 16, 2015, at 12pm.

Applicants will be notified by 12pm Monday (01/19/2015) and will be expected to be in attendance Monday February 2, 2015 at the time and location designated in the Student Enrollment Agreement.
